The Power of Tax Credits

Here is an example:

A company has **500 employees** and experiences **100 percent** turnover.

Of the 500 employees, **15 percent (or 75 employees)** qualify for tax credit.

The credit is worth approximately **\$1,000 per employee**

75 employees x \$1,000 = **\$75,000 in annual tax credits**



WOTC

Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Program: Up to \$9,600 tax credit per employee. You may qualify if you have employees who fit into these categories:

- Disabled or unemployed veteran
- Vocational rehabilitation referral
- Summer youth
- Ex-offender
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipient
- Food stamp recipient
- Designated community resident
- Long-term unemployed
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) – up to a \$9,000 credit

Industries

Organizations with over 100 employees and high turnover of hourly employees tend to receive the biggest benefit from the federal and state employment tax credits. Sample industries include but are not limited to:

- Staffing
- Healthcare
- Hospitality
- Call centers
- Convenience stores
- Restaurant and food chains
- Manufacturers
- Distribution centers
- Grocery stores
- Casinos
- Retail stores

Additional Credits

In addition to the WOTC program, isolved helps businesses with other federal and state employment tax credit programs:

Empowerment Zones

Empowerment Zones are federally designated areas across the country where the Federal government is trying to inspire economic growth and job creation. Employees age 18-40 who live and work in these zones can qualify a business for a tax credit worth up to \$3,000 per employee annually. This program can also be used in conjunction with the WOTC program, enhancing the potential savings available.

State
